On the business front, the chairperson for Legacy investments is Nirvana, while Angelique and Sebastian's brother Gordon sit on the board. The biggest threat to Felicity is Msizi Zulu, the head of Legacy Media and their news channel L24. And in the wings is John, the oldest employee at Legacy, who sees and hears everything. Including Sebastian's murder...

POTGIETER FAMILY

Patriarch Willem Potgieter, has a modest working class family. His son Stefan, a former policeman, works for the Price family as Sebastian's limo driver. Stefan's in a torrid affair with Felicity and will do anything for her. Even murder. His younger sister Petra is out of work, but after Stefan earns a favour from Felicity, he gets his sister a job at Legacy, where she meets SJ and their love story begins.

Kgomotso Christopher is a three-time SAFTA winner. She is famous for her role as Katlego Sibeko in **Isidingo** and as Yvonne Langa in **Scandal!**.

Dineo Price

Kgomotso Christopher as Dineo Price. Sebastian's current wife.

She is smart as a whip and heading up her own division in the company when her hand is forced in another direction.

She was just a flight attendant when she met Sebastian on a business trip to Davos and in 1995, when emotions were running high in post-democratic South Africa, they married. 25 years later, she's still the firecracker in his life. She is beautiful, funny, strong-willed and has a heart of gold beneath all the Gucci. She loves Sebastian and SJ very much. Other than Gordon, the rest of the Price family have never accepted her, especially Felicity. *Mary-Anne Barlow* is best known for her role in Egoli as Coreen Edwards until 2003, before landing a role in British television series, Wild as Heart. Currently, she can be seen as Gail Mathabatha in The River having been introduced to audiences in Season two of the hit telenovela.

Felicity Price

Mary-Anne Barlow as Felicity Price.

Sebastian's eldest daughter on the hunt for her crown as CEO of Legacy Investments.

Felicity is Sebastian's eldest child. And ever since her dad divorced her mother, she's been seeking his approval. She's frighteningly ambitious and from an early age wanted to follow in her father's footsteps. She's worked to get to the top and now the CEO role is within her reach. She has a special place in her heart for SJ, who she considers to be her best friend. She practically raised him alongside her stepmother, who is a few years older than her. Felicity has also met her match in Stefan – a man who is as pathologically ambitious as she is. Anton Jeftha is a relative newcomer who has had smaller roles in US series filmed in SA – most notably as an assassin in Strike Back in 2010, a Marine Sergeant in Homeland in 2011 and as Furiad in Dominion from 2014 to 2015 and as Sim Sim on Jamilah and Aladdin.

SJ Price

Anton David Jeftha as SJ Price.

The charming prodigal son of Dineo and Sebastian.

Sebastian's prodigal son SJ returns from studying abroad with no desire to take on a role at the company. He wants to be a DJ, but when Sebastian goes missing, he is forced to take on an active role to ensure that the Price Family name is secured and that Legacy has a worthy successor. While SJ has always enjoyed a life of privilege, he is a sweet and heartfelt man without an inch of arrogance. But he can be too naïve and trusting, especially of Felicity. And when he meets Petra, his heart melts for her. **Sean Marco Vorster** rose to fame as Jaco du Toit in the SABC 1 drama series Amaza, but in 2019 found a home on Kyknet in the first season of Alles Malan.

Stefan Potgieter

Sean-Marco Vorster as Stefan Potgieter.

The first-born son of Willem Potgieter.

Stefan is sexy and dangerous. He worked as a policeman for many years, but ultimately left the force under slightly unclear circumstances. He still has friends in the police. He's a survivor who truly loves his sister and father. His job as a limo driver to Sebastian Price and his ability to do whatever it takes to get the job done, led him to Felicity. They're having a torrid affair. She's using him, but his ambition to rise to the top with her leads him to kill Sebastian for her and now they share a dark secret together. They are a match made in hell. **Reandi Grey** is an Afrikaans actress with her screen debut as a school girl in Bakgat! in 2008, followed by a string of smaller roles in various feature films before landing her current role as Esti Fouche on 7de Laan in early 2017.

Elizabeth Price

Reandi Grey as Elizabeth Price. The middle sister.

Elizabeth is the second-born daughter of Sebastian and Angelique. She's married to a sociology professor in Cape Town, who we will never meet. She's a type-A personality who the family relies on to get things done. She manages the functions and arranges the search party when Sebastian goes missing. She's invaluable, but her mother never approves of anything she does. The one thing that Angelique and Elizabeth share is their dislike of SJ and love for Felicity.



Michelle Botes is most famous for her role as South Africa's best-loved female anti-hero, Cherel de Villiers on Isidingo, and now thirteen years later returns to the silver screen for Legacy.



Angelique Price

Michelle Botes as Angelique Price. The formidable ex-wife.

Sebastian's ex-wife, Angelique, enters the show once Sebastian has gone missing and takes the media spotlight. She married Sebastian before he was rich and gave up her career as a lawyer to focus on raising her girls so that he could focus on growing his business. Sebastian abandoned her for Dineo and she's carried the bitterness to this day. She's back to support Felicity and her girls and will not allow Dineo or her awful son SJ to claim the CEO title. She serves on the board at Legacy to make sure of that. **Siyabonga Thwala** shot to fame as Paul Mashaba on Generations, then Vuzi Zwane on Scandal! before gaining notoriety as Sengwayo on Isibaya.

Msizi Zulu

The ambitious board member, the head honcho at Legacy Media and L24 news.
