


SEASON ONE

Synopsis

Yann, an intrepid 15-year-old teen and his little 7-year-old sister, Marina, live with their Uncle Patrick, an oceanographer, on Maotu, a remote paradise island in the Pacific Ocean. Yann and Zoom, a mysterious and remarkably intelligent white dolphin, are bound by an indefectible friendship. Always ready to help out those he loves and protect the weak, Zoom takes Yann on a series of exciting adventures, set in the fascinating, fragile and danger-filled underwater world, as well as on dry land.

Comedy and humor are central to the series, expressed through a host of colorful characters including Raoul, Marina's pet koala; John-Sebastian, the chatterbox mynah bird; Loaf, the sloth; and other inhabitants of Maotu Island.





SEASON TWO

Synopsis

In the second season, our heroes and their Polynesian friends, Timeti, now an apprentice shaman, and Auru, the son of Maotu's chief, are confronted with fresh challenges, some border on the dangerous. Whether it's an oil slick threatening the coastline or a baby orca creating havoc, they have to find double the courage to come to the rescue of Maotu, its wildlife and its people.



SEASON THREE

Synopsis

In Season 3 Yann is now working as intern at Manava research center. There he meets Nino, a brilliant but clumsy scientist and his daughter, Maimiti, a teenage computer genius. With the help of Anita, the vet, Yann must make sure the wild animals brought to Manava can be released safely and also take care of the permanent resi-dents, such as Daisy, the mischievous sea lion, Bobby, the shy octopus, and Bubbles, the greedy dugong...

Timeti has completed her apprenticeship as shaman while Auru is still trying to prove that he is the worthy heir to his dad, the village chief. Our heroes continue to protect their atoll against many environmental threats. They also run into old foes: the billionaire Van Krook, and Terrence Werner, a lawless, tycoon, who roams the seas aboard his impressive submarine.





A SUPER INTELLIGENT WHITE DOLPHIN!

He's Yann's best friend. Perfectly white, with blue-ringed eyes. He isunique. He's an intelligent, playful and free animal – closer to humans than to his fellows. His family is Yann, Marina and Patrick. He adopted them rather than the other way around. Brave and instinctive, Zoom faces every danger for Yann and his friends. To call Zoom, Yann beats the "Zoom Signal" - a recognizable rhythm that spreads out through the water. It can be played on the dock or on the hull of a boat.

It's fair to say that, in addition to his other talents, Zoom has a perfect understanding of the language of all animals. We shall continue to pay very special attention to the acting of the cetaceans to render their dialogue comprehensible to our audience.

The protector of Maotu

We don't exactly know where he comes from but Zoom seems to have a close bond with the island of Maotu. In fact, many of the island's legends mention the "white dolphin, protector of the island of Maotu".

YANN

Yann is an intrepid 16-year-old and experienced scuba diver who is terribly awkward around girls. Particularly, around Timeti, on whom he has a crush.


Yann is the main character in the series. He's a boy who, although reserved, loves action.

He's inventive, resourceful, courageous and sometimes a little obstinate. He's stubborn as a mule but has a heart of gold. Yannadores his little sister, Marina, for whom he feels responsible, and he has a great deal of admiration for Uncle Patrick.

In this third season, Yann has finally succeeded in obtaining an internship at the Veterinary Center and Institute of Oceanographic Research of Manava, headed by Uncle Patrick.

Walking in his uncle's footsteps, Yann, with the help of his friends, will do all he can to preserve the flora and fauna of Maotu and its surrounding area.





MARINA

Marina is a bright, bubbly, very girly 8-year-old. She talks non-stop which proves tiresome to Yann and Uncle Patrick. She is often disobedient, but she's so adorable that she is always forgiven. Armed with a sharp sense of curiosity and an adventurer's spirit, she loves all kinds of animals, especially Raoul, her pet koala, she calls him, "my baby," takes him everywhere with her, and generally treats him like a doll.

Marina is bursting with energy and has an infectious happiness. On the other hand, she needs a lot of affection and attention.

Despite her young age, she often manages to understand the signals that the "grown-ups" don't immediately pick-up. That's why she has no hesitation in pushing her big brother towards Timeti and vice versa.

When interacting with her friends, Kai, Onaku and Tevaiti, Marina can behave like a big sister. That way she comes to understand that, although Yann may sometimes bug her, he always has good intentions.



TiMeTi

Timeti is a pretty 15-year-old Polynesian. She lives with her mother, Maeva, who runs a store/restaurant in the village.

This young, athletic, sparkling and mischievous girl is Yann's best friend.

She's got a soft spot for him, but she's also close to Auru, the son of the chief.

She knows all the traditional dances, plays the ukulele and is proudly protective of her traditions. She is an excellent surfer and kitesurfer and likes to meet up with her friends Yann and Auru during competitions or to embark on adventures.

Formerly apprentice shaman, Timeti is now Ramana's assistant. In spite of his support, she still needs to prove herself and thus gain the complete confidence of Maotu's villagers.

For this third season, Timeti proves she can take over from Ramana once he'll decide to retire.



AURU

Auru is a 15-year-old Polynesian.

He's the son of Papa-Tuanaku, the village chief. As Papa Tuanaku's heir, Auru sometimes thinks he's already chief and he "acts like it".

He's a boaster, a show-off who likes to joke and show off his muscles, but who can also prove to be a bit of a coward, especially when faced with unexplained phenomena.

He likes to taunt Yann by laying down challenges. But confrontation between the two young roosters conceals a very real spirit of mutual support and camaraderie, even though, they will never admit it.

In Season 3, Auru is still very much in love with Clarissa. He's no longer in competition with Yann for Timeti's heart but that doesn't stop Auru from teasing him. In this new season, Auru tries to spend as much time as possible with his friends.

Now possessor of a Poti-Marara, Auru intends to become the best fisherman in the entire archipelago!

UNCLE PATRICK

Uncle Patrick is a 56-year-old seadog, a bit gruff, but with rather free-spirited hippie tendencies.

He's a reputed oceanographer, settled on the island of Maotu in order to carry out his research on the underwater world and the preservation of species in peace. Until the day when his nephew and niece, Yann and Marina, turned up on the island to move in with him. Since then, he regards them as his own children.

Uncle Patrick represents parental authority, but he also knows that he can rely upon Yann under any circumstances and is soft on Marina, totally unable to deny her anything.

He's also a great inventor: "The Turtle" and his boat, "The Taaora" are his major achievements.

In this third season, we can see Uncle Patrick in his professional setting. He is, in fact, the director of the Manava Center. This post brings huge responsibilities that cause him to be less present for his niece and nephew than he might wish to be.



RAOUL

Raoul was brought back from Australia by Uncle Patrick after he was abandoned by his mother.

He's Marina's pet and she calls him all sorts of nicknames: "My baby! Fat pudding! Pops!".

Raoul makes himself understood by uttering little sounds: yips of joy, snarls for John-Sebastian, who squabbles with him non-stop, squeals of fright when it's time for his bath, whimpering when he's done something really silly and Marina scolds him.

Raoul, with his funny faces and endless pranks, represents a breath of air that is both cute and comic in the series.

We will feel sorry for him when we see Marina trying, for the nth time, to give him a bath.


JOHN-SEBASTIAN


John-Sebastian is a talking mynah bird.

He can imitate any sounds. Although he speaks, his language is still very limited. He's a birdbrain, who misunderstands everything. He often raises the alarm to Uncle Patrick when the kids are in trouble.

John-Sebastian is secretly jealous of the affection Marina heaps on her koala, Raoul. There's a constant stream of taunting and squabbling between them. He finds comfort on Uncle Patrick's shoulder, and he'd willingly lose his last feather for him.

VAN KROOK

Van Krook is 50.

But beneath the facade lies a hypocritical, greedy, amoral and cowardly man, only interested in his personal enrichment.

Van Krook claims that his ancestors discovered the island of Maotu and, because of that, it belongs to him.

He lives aboard a huge yacht, equipped with a pocket submarine.

Van Krook sometimes works on commission for outsiders. He is assisted by two henchmen: Biff and Rico.

Following the arrival of his niece on his yacht, Van Krook has no choice but to conceal a part of his activities from her, as she does not support his shenanigans.

In this new season, faced with the threat represented by Terrence Werner, towards whom he nurtures a deep hatred, Van Krook sometimes helps our heroes to throw a wrench in his gears.



AVSAM

Maeva is a woman of 41, in full bloom and independent. She runs a store/restaurant in the village: "Maeva's Place". She's a great cook with her own specials, including chicken fafa, which she serves to her customers on the restaurant terrace.

Maeva is Timeti's mother. They are very close to each other and have built up a deep complicity.

Maeva was convinced that Timeti would take over her restaurant and has had to come to terms with contradictory emotions, from pride to incomprehension, faced with her daughter and her desire to become shaman.

Maeva is able to share her confusion with her mother, Faratina, Timeti's grandmother, who regularly lends a hand in the kitchen.

TAHURA RAMANA

The Great Shaman Ramana is Maotu's shaman. He is respected by the people and sits on the great council. She lives in a hut in the mangrove, away from the village, near the volcano. The mangrove is surrounded by salt water, which enables Zoom to get close.

Ramana is a highly colorful character, with unpredictable and comic behavior. He can go from the seriousness of an incantation to the most complete derision without any transition. Although advanced in years, he is incredibly agile. Ramana possesses the "Mana": spiritual strength endowing its possessor with "supernatural" power.

In the third season, Ramana takes a lesser role, leaving more space for Timeti to prove herself to the villagers. As a good mentor, however, he isnever too far away to advise and assist his young protegee.

FARATINA

Faratina is Timeti's grandmother.

She has a great sense of humor and is very close with her granddaughter. She sometimes plays the diplomat between her daughter and granddaughter, who don't always agree.

She encourages her granddaughter in her vocation as assistant shaman and has known Ramana very well ever since she was a child. As a result, she became open to shamanism very early. Even though she enjoys her retirement, she sometimes comes to lend Maeva a hand whenever there are lots of customers in the store or restaurant.

She's a dynamic, funny grandmother who provides support for Timeti whenever she needs it.



JACK

Jack is a 39-years-old American, skinny, gaunt, and unshaven. He's an adventurer, a treasure hunter.

Jack lives from bartering and minor dealings, sometimes on the limits of the law. He's curious, talkative and a smooth talker, always looking out for a good deal. He gets around in a taxi-boat in which he sometimes carries inhabitants from island to island. He also flies a seaplane and delivers the mail.

Uncle Patrick and Jack are old friends, even though, they don't share the same ideas. Yann really likes Jack, because whenever he shows up there's the promise of adventure.

In this new season, Jack is still accompanied by his dog, Jackpot whose has become his best friend. Jack will do anything to protect him.

JACKPOT

Jack, the adventurous lone wolf, lived alone on his barge surviving from several activities: taxi for the rare passing tourists, parcel and mail delivery in his seaplane, a bit of fishing, a bit of bartering and lots of hunting for treasure.

Despite all this, Jack felt a little loneso me and decided to adopt a puppy named "Jackpot"! Since then, the two friends never leave each other's side.

KAÏ

Kaï is a young Polynesian boy of 5.

He's a distant cousin of Timeti, who is sometimes given the job of babysitting him... Just when her pals call her to come surfing!

When with him, Marina tends to act like a big sister, in the same way that Yann behaves towards her. But little Kaï quickly proves to be very clingy towards Marina, whom he adores.

He's a comic character. He can go in the water with armbands. He doesn't always express himself very well but Zoom understands him perfectly.



RAHi

Rahi is a loner and dangerous giant tiger shark who nurses a limitless hatred for Zoom. During a battle between the two, Rahi lost part of a fin and several teeth.

Rahi prowls in the depths and is rarely seen near the coasts.

Even though he remains a danger to our heroes, a special place is allocated to Rahi and his fellows to demonstratejust how important sharks are to the ecosystem.

BIFF AND RICO

Biff and Rico are Van Krook's henchmen, although they sometimes pull off petty crimes by themselves, especially when it involves poaching or illegal fishing.

Rico is the leader of the duo. He's thin, gaunt, and twitchy. He lords it over Biff giving him orders in a rough way.

Biff is big, fat heavy and pretty stupid. He carries out Rico's orders without any reflection. He can crack his knuckles and look threatening, but he's a softie at heart. Now friends with Bubbles, the dugong and one of Manava's center resident, Biff secretly wants to live a peaceful life on Maotu.

CLARISSA

Clarissa is a beautiful girl about the same age as Timeti. Auru falls in love the very day he met her. She is spending her vacation on the yacht of her uncle, the vile Van Krook, who will use her and her innocence to achieve his own ends.

However, Clarissa, beneath her haughty airs, is a lonely girl who is not fully aware of the consequences of her actions.

This spoilt young city girl, a keen fan of technology and gadgetery will upset the balance of the band of friends because she falls slightly for Yann which sparks Timeti's jealousy. In this third season, she is increasingly aware of Auru's charms, but that won't stop her from driving him nuts.



PAPA-TUANAKU

Papa-Tuanaku is an imposing man of 51, bearing a magnificent tattoo. He's the village chief.

He proudly presides over the council, settles conflicts, organizes traditional celebrations (Heiva) and sporting competitions.

He is often rapidly overwhelmed by his responsibilities and then he turns to his wife for advice.

TAPUNA

Tapuna is an elegant 41-year-old woman. She's the chief's wife.

Tapuna is a former "Miss Polynesia" which she's very proud of.

She gives herself rather superior airs but deep down, she has a big heart. She's also particularly protective of her little brother: Nino.

Despire their differences, Tapuna and Maeva are friends.

LOAF

Loaf is a sloth who spends his time sleeping, hanging from one of the bamboo structures forming the veranda.

Occasionally, he may emit a little grunt as he casually observes the family bustling around him.

In this third season, Loaf, although unwillingly, takes part in some big adventures alongside his friends.



NAONe

He is the chief of Hawutai, a neighboring island, a day's canoe trip from Maotu.

Chief Naone sometimes comes to visit his counterpart, Papa-Tuanaku. As Auru and Yann, Papa-Tuanaku and Naone are as much friends than rivals.

The two men are different and don't share the same values. Whereas on Maotu, villagers have chosen to live in harmony with nature by adhering to their ancestral customs, Naone and his people have chosen to westernize... and enjoy the pleasures of traffic jams.

Carefree by nature, Naone sometimes triggers disasters, notably ecological ones, in the archipelago. As he does this without ever being fully aware of his actions, it has the effect of driving Papa-Tuanaku mad.

ONAKU

Onaku is 7. He's got quite a temper and often quarrels with Marina to determine who's going to be chief of their little gang.

TEVAITI

Tevaiti is the youngest of the group.

She is friends with Marina, whom she sees as a big sister. She is very impressed by Yann and his bond with Zoom.





NINO New in season 3

Nino is a 40-year-old Polynesian and a native of Maotu. He is Tapuna's younger brother and, so, Auru's uncle.

A great scientist, Nino runs the lab, where he carries out biological research inspired by the marine world. Always seeking some new clean energy, a medicine or revolutionary diving gear, he is really devoted to putting his intelligence to the service of others to make the world a better place. However, that has not always been the case. When young, he was actually working for the merciless Werner, but when his daughter, Maimiti, was born he decided to change path and work for the common good.

Both brilliant and scatter-brained, Nino, it must be said, is terribly clumsy. Not a day goes by without him tripping over a cable or falling head-first into a pool!

Pleasant and nutty, Nino is a mad, flamboyant scientist, whom Patrick sometimes finds hard to channel.

Despite their very different characters, they complement each other and form a team that is both efficient and competent!

MAIMITI New in season 3

Maimiti is Nino's daughter. She lives at the Manava Center with her father and Anita. She's a 12-year-old endowed with a formidable intelligence. Passionate about computers, she spends her time developing software and incredible devices to help the Center preserve the flora and fauna. With her nose always glued to her screens, she's really good at irritating her cousin, Auru, with whom she quarrels all the time. Plus, family reunions are not really her thing. She's always looking for a good excuse to stay at home.

Timid by nature, she genuinely admires Yann, Auru and Timeti, who never flinch from going into action to rescue animals and their friends... To tell the truth, the mere idea of having to dive into the depths, fight bad guys or even just climb onto a surfboard is sheer torture for her. So, she often remains at the Center, where she acts as technical officer.

However, she can overcome her worst fears and go into action when the situation demands it. Sharp-witted and sarcastic, she has a stinging sense of humor that often hits home... especially when it's a question of pricking her cousin's ego!





BOBBY

NEW IN SEASON 3

Bobby is an octopus, both curious and fearful. He lives in a large and splendid aquarium near Uncle Patrick's office. He can get out whenever he likes, but he usually prefers to hide in the diver's helmet that decorates his little home.

He tends to be averse to a lot of movement, but when his curiosity is pricked, he always ends up by coming out of his hiding place to see what's going on at the Center.

His camouflage skills enable him to change color as he pleases and to melt into the background to escape from Daisy, who wants to play with him constantly, but also from all his potential enemies.

Remarkably intelligent, Bobby is equally skilled and agile underwater so, good luck to anyone who tries to catch him!

DAISY New in season 3

Daisy is a pretty sea lion that lives at the Center. She's very playful and spends her time taunting her fellow resident, Bobby, the octopus, constantly hounding him, and playing with Zoom, who she adores!

She's extremely skillful and can juggle with almost anything you toss her way. In fact, she used to work in a water park where Anita sometimes attended as vet. Falling under the sea lion's charm and saddened to see her suffering ill treatment, Anita brought her back to live with her at the Center.

Too tame to be set free, she is forced to live in the Center's large pools. However, Patrick and Anita do everything to make her feel as happy as possible. And she does! Her communicating joy is a real ray of sunshine for Manava.





ANITA

Anita is an internationally renowned vet specializing in animal behavior. She's a former colleague and friend of Uncle Patrick so, when hedecided to create the Manava Center he immediately thought of her to take care of the animals there. Extremely conscientious about her work, she tends to put pressure on herself and finds it hard to forgive the rare mistakes she makes. Fortunately, her friends Nino and Patrick are always there to support her.

Uncle Patrick has always had a serious crush on her, but Anita remains a deep mystery concerning her feelings for the old seadog... although it seems likely that she is not entirely insensitive to his charms...

Our heroes can rely on her expertise whenever an a nimal starts behaving strangely or when one of them develops health problems. She has at her disposal a high-end veterinary clinic right in the heart of the Manava Center with all the equipment needed to treat the animals, even the largest ones!

BUBBLes

Bubbles is a huge dugong convalescing at the Manava Center.

Due to a blunder by Biff and Rico, Maotu's sea grass beds were devastated, and Bubbles was left starving. So, he's found refuge at the Center while the beds grow back, and he can return to freedom.

Meanwhile, he's having a fine time in the company of Daisy, Bobby and Zoom, who enjoy his good humor and warmth.

TERRENCE WERNER

A shady billionaire, Terrence Werner has become our heroes' worst nightmare. As head of the Werner Company, he disposes of unlimited resources to loot, destroy and pollute...

He roams the seas in his giant submarine, on the lookout for the slightest opportunity to increase the profits from his already immense fortune. He always has a close eye on the Manava Center and the numerous discoveries and inventions made by Nino and Maimiti. He's keeping an eye on them and won't hesitate from ordering his men to steal from them. Werner is also fascinated by rare animal specimens and especially by Zoom, which he dreams of capturing and adding to his collection.

Manipulative, unscrupulous and merciless, he almost makes Van Krook look like a choir boy. However, the two of them hate each other and on the rare occasions they did join forces, Van Krook always finished by turning his back on him, considering that he was going too far. Today, he is our heroes' greatest enemy.



HECTOR

He is Werner's righthand man, commanding his army of bodyguards.

Hector is built like a fridge and sends shivers down the spine of anybody he meets. Cold and professional, nothing daunts him when carrying out the missions his boss gives him.

Far more intelligent and competent than Biff and Rico, he will often make our heroes' lives difficult.

WiM

Wim is Anita's nephew.

He's still very young and cannot speak yet. He mumbles a few words and names such as "Yann" and "Zoom".

Marina thinks he looks just like Yann when hewas a baby.


For some days now, the waters of Maotou have been disturbed. Yann is concerned and decides to alert Papa-Tuanaku.





THE TURTLE SEASON 2

This is a bathyscaphe invented by Uncle Patrick. Concentrated technology. It can hold up to six people and is capable of reaching the deep abyss (+4,000m).






