The Zweiflers

Family patriarch and Holocaust survivor Symcha Zweifler wants to sell his delicatessen empire when suddenly he is confronted with his past in Frankfurt's red light district just after WWII — an acid test for the whole family as long-suppressed conflicts resurface. Who, if not Symcha's grandson Samuel, should carry on his grandfather's life's work? But Samuel's British Caribbean girlfriend, Saba, has other plans. Things get worse when Samuel and Saba are expecting a son.

Samuel's sister Dana, who has found her anchor in religion and has travelled all the way from Israel to celebrate the circumcision of the newborn in Frankfurt, is confronted with old conflicts and repressed secrets in her hometown. She does everything in her power to take over her grandfather's business.

The youngest sibling, Leon, is clearly the loser in the return of his two older siblings. When he invites the family to his first exhibition, in which he shows his provocative family portraits, a scandal ensues.

Mimi, the mother of the three, always walks a fine line between caring and manipulation. How far will she go to bring her children closer to her again? Her husband, Jackie, a psychiatrist, is in the middle of a belated midlife crisis, including an affair with his patient. He is tired of always being the family punching bag.

The grandparents, Symcha and Lilka Zweifler, are the undisputed rulers of the family. But their strength and lifespan are slowly beginning to fade. A tragicomic search for the meaning of life begins, culminating in decisions that will change the lives of everyone involved.

And to make sure that their lives aren't unnecessarily easy, two secret police agents are constantly breathing down their neck – tough agent Snížková and sweetheart Hora.

A dramatic, gripping family saga, concurrent storylines run past and present as *White Night* Season Two takes us back to the 80s. No longer satisfied with her modelling career, Louise Hébert-Lacombe's (Rose-Marie Perreault) dreams of setting up a cosmetics company with her friend and former neighbour Jacinthe. Thanks in part to mentor Aidrian, Nocturne was born, developing into a powerhouse cosmetic industry empire. In her relentless pursuit of opulence, fame, and power, Louise must face major adverse events, maturing into present-day Loulou (France Castel). Meanwhile, Aidrian, obsessed with protecting and further propelling Loulou's success, lets himself be dominated more and more by his dark side. Murdered on the eve of the launch of her new fragrance, the Hébert clan embarks on a pursuit to find LouLou's killer. Though seemingly solved, it appears that Clémence killed Loulou. What Aidrian and the Hébert children

don't know, but soon realise, is that Clémence did not act alone but had an accomplice. Familial bonds fray in their pursuit of this other culprit, with the Hébert clan beginning to tear each other apart. Revelations highlight cracks in each of the characters, generating suspicion, betrayal and shameful secrets that severely test family loyalty and lay a web of self-destruction. Thrown into situations that force them to cross boundaries, their decisions could have serious consequences that may forever undermine the ties that bind them. Will the clan survive the ordeal?

Concordia

Once a struggling town, Skällrea was reborn as Concordia under Juliane Ericksen's vision.

A town built on surveillance and data collection – not for nefarious self-serving purposes but for the greater good of society and its citizens. Its leadership's sole goal is to create a freer, fairer, and more humane society – for today and tomorrow. By its 20th anniversary, Concordia is thriving – an indisputable success and on the verge of expansion. The town is only 9 days away from announcing the export and launch of its technology in the German city of

Kopwitz, when a catastrophe hits: the town's first ever murder – an employee at Concordia HQ.

And as the team around Isabelle Larsson, a Concordia devotee, and Thea Ryan, an external crisis manager, races to solve the crime, a second disaster shocks the town: a hack of the town's impenetrable AI. Together, these events compromise the very foundation of the Concordia project – and undermine any possibility of expansion. When the team discovers that an international anti-surveillance group called 'The Faceless' could be behind the crime and may have access to the system, the threat becomes increasingly urgent and even life-threatening. Feelings

In this moody and atmospheric coming-of-age story, a teenager traverses friendship, self-doubts and love in a secluded village deep in a mystical forest. But as a mysterious darkness that hides in the woods begins to creep out, the line between reality and fantasy begins to fade.

After her father decides to relocate them from the city to the village of Lohweide, social misfit Alva (16) is far from pleased with her new surroundings. She is having trouble finding her place in the close-knit community, especially when stories about her missing uncle begin to circulate, making her feel more alone than ever before.

That is until she meets Esma (17). With notable make-up and a self-assured attitude, Esma is one of a kind. Unlike Alva, Esma doesn't care about fitting in. Encouraged by their developing friendship, Alva is trying to let go of the

difficult life she left behind and as her feelings towards Esma begin to intensify, Alva realises she's in love.

But her hopes of a genuine connection are overshadowed by strange goings-on in the forest. There is something there that seems to call to Alva. She sees an ominous glow between the trees, curious mushrooms and a dark shadow that is frightening her. As the forest beckons her in, Alva senses that something is terribly wrong.

Boundless

Rejected by the King of Portugal to finance an expedition to mythical lands in pursuit of priceless spices, explorer Ferdinand Magellan convinces the Spanish Crown to fund the mission that will take an unexplored ocean route west.

Setting sail 500 years ago with 5 Spanish ships and a crew of 265 men, including commander and former prisoner Juan Sebastián Elcano, Magellan's journey would face sabotage by the Portuguese, as well as hostile Spanish foes. With unimaginable suffering – starvation, death and punishing weather – sailors resorted to mutiny after a year at sea until finally finding the Strait of Magellan. A critical juncture after reaching the Philippines would test leadership, requiring captain and crew to battle the indigenous tribes, resulting in disastrous losses before continuing their journey.

Former anti-hero, Elcano, not Magellan, would lead the expedition to glory, returning 3 years later with 18 survivors and a hull full of spices, as captain of one of the greatest navigational triumphs. This legacy of travelling to the Earth's unknown ends would change man's perception of the world and the existence of an ocean route west.

Directed by Simon West (producer of Oscar-nominated *Black Hawk Down*), *Boundless* features high production values shot in locales including the Dominican Republic, the Basque Country, Madrid and Seville.

The Swarm

The Swarm is an eight-part thriller series from Emmy Award-winning showrunner Frank Doelger (*Game of Thrones*).

The world's oceans are exhibiting strange happenings causing global unrest. Engaged by an oil company to conduct a biological survey, Sigur Johanson, a professor of marine biology, discovers a destabilising ice worm threatening the continental shelf and triggering tsunamis. Molecular biologist Cécile Roche struggles with deadly bacteria poisoning drinking water, while whale researcher Leon Anawak tries to explain why the largest ocean mammals are displaying unusually dangerous behaviour, aggressively attacking boats. The Shadow

Norah is in Vienna, looking for a fresh start when a stranger with a terrifying prophecy changes everything. *The Shadow*, a gripping psychological drama series from ZDFneo, is adapted from the best-selling book by Melanie Raabe and questions whether even the most moral humans can be manipulated to cross ethical boundaries.

As he drops Felix at a theatre project on a farm run by Elisa, his interaction with the warm but distracted farm owner is anything but friendly as he doesn't trust that

Felix is safe there – especially when he sees his son overexerting himself.

The moment Felix locks eyes with Emma, another participant on the farm, sparks fly and the pair become inseparable. When a letter from Emma's estranged grandfather arrives from Italy, the pair decide to run away together to visit him. Realising the couple have disappeared, Elisa, along with Alexander, drops everything and begins a desperate search for the young lovers.

During the pursuit of the pair, Alexander and Elisa gradually put their differences aside and begin to bond. She reveals to him that she herself had a daughter with Down's syndrome who recently died. But
