When Lalo has to move out of his ex's apartment, he stays with his best friend Karla. Karla is achieving her

career goals in the financial world, but is struggling with growing exhaustion and an overbearing boss. Lalo's need for support is also wearing on her. Everyone demands her attention – but it seems no one notices how increasingly lonely Karla feels. Meanwhile, Lalo is losing it more and more. He refuses to let his mother Marion clear out his father's belongings. Instead he seeks solace with the artist Joshua with whom he falls head over heels in love. Perhaps, as his friend Bijan teases, Lalo needs

therapy. Amid quick-witted banter and speechlessness, generational conflicts and chosen family, flirting and growing pains, Lalo and Karla try to become the people they want to be – while chaos erupts around them.

Things We Fear

In an effort to help calm her worsening panic attacks, 17-year-old Lisa moves to the Black Forest with her mother Franka. But their new beginning in the secluded town is overshadowed by sinister events. It's been exactly a year since a deadly shooting occurred at the local school. And on the day of the anniversary, the suicide of a police officer sends another shock wave through the town.

Franka is puzzled by the events and having started her new role in the local police force, she begins investigating but soon hits a brick wall. Franka is not the only one up against it – Lisa is haunted by eerie apparitions as the spir-its of the dead try to communicate with her. Determined to find out what they want, she delves into the past.

Meanwhile, the son of the local pastor of a small free church community, Simon, is dealing with his father's disapproval of his homo-sexuality, and faces conversion therapy in a nearby place in the woods called 'The Waldhaus'. But soon the cruel methods of the therapy leader become unbearable, and Simon tries to escape. As Franka presses ahead with her investigation, everything seems to lead to 'The Waldhaus'. But as she arrives there, she finds herself in unexpected danger.

Back at school, Lisa is gradually able to piece together the puzzle of the shooting. She realises what really happened a year ago – and that the danger has not yet been averted. In a dramatic confrontation in the catacombs of the school, she not only has to confront the real perpetrator, but also the dead.

Hoodie

Hoodie is a superhero story about a perfectly normal boy, with an exceptional talent for parkour and a passion for justice. He has secretly been practicing parkour with Soufian, the best tracer in Brussels. He has been doing so in secret, as his mother, a passionate police officer, would never approve it. One day when a woman is robbed near his house, Pieter hesitates only briefly. He pulls his hoodie over his head and chases the robber using his parkour skills. He skilfully jumps over walls, traversing gardens and roofs...

without being recognized. And so the legend of "Hoodie – fighter of crime" is created. When three neighbourhood kids, Flo, Basim and Kenza, discover Pieter's talent and motivation, they join him to become an unexpected superhero crew: Team Hoodie. They are connected by one goal: to liberate the neighbourhood from injustice.

In season 2, Pieter and his three friends join together to free Vrijbeek from a hit-and-run vandal. Pieter locates his arch-rival Soufian and brings him back to Brussels, to train Hoodie back to superhero fitness.

But Soufian's arrival threatens to break up Pieter's team.

In the 3rd season Pieter's mother discovers his secret, but he decides to bring her into the team to free Vrijbeek, together with his friends, from a fake Hoodie who steals rather than protects.

Feelings

In this moody and atmospheric coming-of-age story, a teenager traverses friendship, self-doubts and love in a secluded village deep in a mystical forest. But as a mysterious darkness that hides in the woods begins to creep out, the line between reality and fantasy begins to fade.

After her father decides to relocate them from the city to the village of Lohweide, social misfit Alva (16) is far from pleased with her new surroundings. She is having trouble finding her place in the close-knit community, especially when stories about her missing uncle begin to circulate, making her feel more alone than ever before.

That is until she meets Esma (17). With notable make-up and a self-assured attitude, Esma is one of a kind. Unlike Alva, Esma doesn't care about fitting in. Encouraged by their developing friendship, Alva is trying to let go of the difficult life she left behind and as her feelings towards Esma begin to intensify, Alva realises she's in love.

But her hopes of a genuine connection are overshadowed by strange goings-on in the forest. There is something there that seems to call to Alva. She sees an ominous glow between the trees, curious mushrooms and a dark shadow that is frightening her. As the forest beckons her in, Alva senses that something is terribly wrong.
